



IBA – ACQUISITION OF OWN SHARES

Immediate Release – January 31st, 2022

Louvain-la-Neuve, Belgium, January 31st, 2022 - In accordance with article 8:4 of the Royal Decree of 29 April 2019 executing the Belgian Code on Companies and Associations, Ion Beam Applications SA (“IBA”) hereby discloses information in relation to its share buyback program announced on December 3rd, 2021.

Under this program, IBA has requested a financial intermediary to repurchase up to 400.000 IBA ordinary shares on its behalf under the terms of a discretionary mandate agreement with validity until June 30th, 2022, effective as from December 6th, 2021, to cover the remaining portion of the company’s obligations under a long term incentive plan granted to certain members of its personnel in 2021.

In the framework of this share buyback program, IBA repurchased 17.561 IBA shares on Euronext Brussels in the period from January 24th, 2022 up to and including January 28th, 2022, as follows:
