Covid Safe Ticket .

The event is accessible to people who have a valid **Covid Safe Ticket**, which must be presented at the entrance along with an ID or, failing that, a passport or driving licence. You will be asked to wear a face mask until the identification of the Covid Safe Ticket has been completed. Outside of the event areas, all regulations apply. We invite you to pay attention to the health signs that will be put in place and to wash your hands regularly at the dedicated points on the site.

If you don't have a Covid Safe Ticket yet, you can get it:

- Via an official app that can be downloaded to your mobile phone at <https://covidsafe.be/en/>
- Via the website www.masante.belgique.be / www.mijngezondheid.belgie.be

We strongly advise you obtain it at least the day before the event.

Access to the event will be given once you have fulfilled one of these conditions:

- Have a valid vaccination certificate from 14 days after the second injection or single dose (depending on the type of vaccine).
- Have a PCR test with a negative result that is less than 48 hours old.
- Have a certificate of recovery valid from 10 days after the date of the first positive PCR test to 180 days after the date of the first positive test.
- Have a rapid antigen test performed by a properly trained healthcare professional that yields a negative result:
 - For this rapid antigen test: validity = day of collection + 24 hours (1 day)

If the scan of the QR Code of your Covid Safe Ticket proves negative, access to the event will unfortunately be denied.

If you leave the areas invested by the event, you are likely to present a valid Covid Safe Ticket in order to re-enter.
